There are requirements from the Regulations depending on the concentration of PCBs in your equipmeThe Regulation prescribe end-of-use deadlines for specific equipment (if they were in use on September 5, 2008) and liquids containing PC follows:

Equipment/liquid containing PCBs	End-of-use date
Equipment with a PCB concentration of 50 mg/kg of more but less than 500 mg/kg (not located at prescribed locations	December 31, 2025
Light ballasts and pole-top transformers and their auxiliary pole-top electrical equipmenwith a PCB concentration of 50 mg/kg or more	
Current transformers, potential transformers, circle breakers, reclosers and bushings-located at an electrical generation, transmission or distribution facility with a PCB concentration of 500 mg/kg comore	
Equipmentand liquidswith a PCB concentration c 500 mg/kg or more	December 31, 2009 (or December 31, 2014, if was granted an extension by the Minister to the
Equipment with a PCB concentration of 50 mg/kg of more but less than 500 mg/kg located at prescribed locations	December 31, 2009 end-of-use)

Once the equipment or liquid is removed from use, it may be subject to the storage, labelling, destruction and repo requirements of the Regulations**Note:** Equipment that were subject to the December 31, 2009 and the December 31, 2014 deadlines must already be destroyed, according to the timelines under the Regulatic

Owners of equipment or products containing PCBs are legally responsible for their proper handling and disposal, including all reporting requirements for the use, storage, shipment and destruction of PCI
